## 13 Giving a presentation in groups

### Stage 1

Student A: give your presentation.

Student B: you are a kind critic. Write down any examples of good English that you hear.

Student C: you are a harsh critic. Write down any mistakes you hear.

Students D, E, etc.: write down questions you want to ask when Student A has finished.

### Stage 2

In groups, Students D, E, etc. ask their questions and Student A answers them.

### Stage 3

Students B and C give their kind critic / harsh critic reports. The group discusses the reports.
